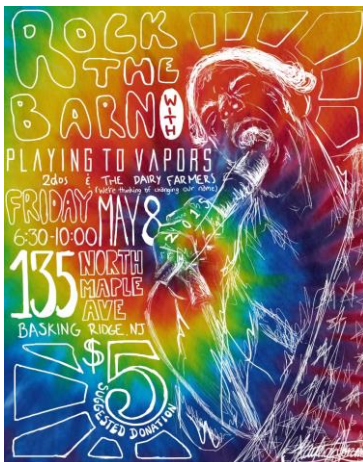


THE ROSS FARM

The poster should:

~ Illustrate one (or more) of the "Founding Fathers" of the Ross Farm and the barn at the Ross Farm!

~ Be fun, colorful and eye catching so that the show feels welcoming to all!

~ Be 11x17 in size, vertical or horizontal. (Please do not submit a different size. Posters that do not fit the size requirement will not be considered.) Digital image must be a high resolution PDF that is made to size 11x17.

ENTRY FORM:

One entry per student will be accepted for this contest.

Each entry must be original in concept, design and execution and not violate any U.S. copyright laws.

Student/parent/teacher may be required to certify authenticity.

All entrants must submit the following information with their artwork: Name, grade, school (if applicable), mailing address, email and phone contact information.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Submissions will be judged on the following criteria:

~ Clarity of communicating theme "Rock the Barn" to viewer & required information

~ Artistic merit, creative expression

CONTEST DATES & DEADLINES

All entries must be hand delivered to Nola Hansen between 4 and 5 pm on March 13 at The Ross Farm, 135 N. Maple Ave., Basking Ridge. If you are submitting a digital image for consideration, a hard copy must also be hand delivered.
